PADDY COOK EVANGELISM SEMINAR

Paddy Cook is an evangelist was born in Cambridge, England and grew up in Brighton. He studied under the late Dr. Francis Schaeffer in Switzerland and is a graduate of Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis. He is currently a PCA Teaching Elder. Paddy and his wife Sheila, have 4 children all walking with the Lord. He has traveled extensively, to some 62 countries in Europe and the Middle and near East, and for the last 29 years has worked as a Presbyterian Evangelist, with PEF (Presbyterian Evangelistic Fellowship) pefministry.org. This link - <http://pefministry.org/Cook.html> will give you a taste of what God has been doing through Paddy. On each trip, Paddy takes \$2000 worth of new theological books, 200 Ultimate Questions in the language of the country to practice and teach personal evangelism. His goal is to reach every country in Europe. Paddy has written "*Boldly Proclaiming - The Message and Methods of God-centered Witnessing*," and teaches individuals and churches how to practically talk to people about Jesus outside the church.
