

“Motivation for Hardship Part 1”


*2 Timothy 2:8-10*





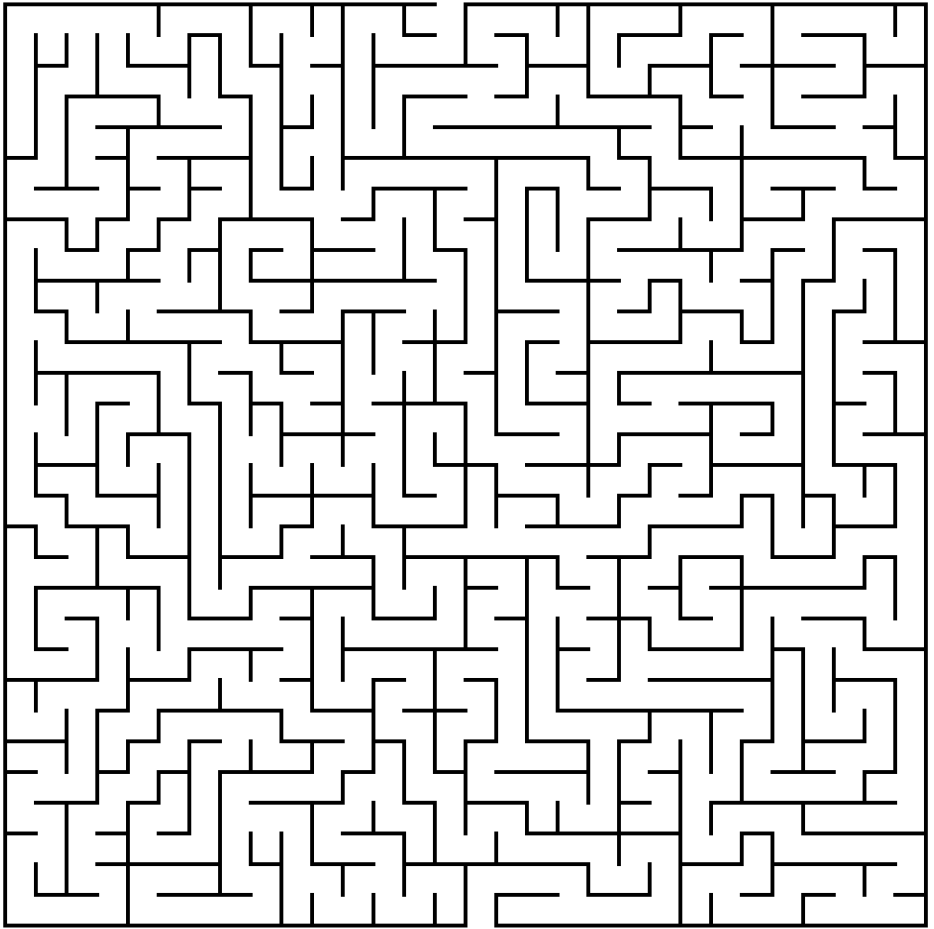
