And in a vision he has seen a man named Ananias coming in and putting *his* hand on him, so that he might receive his sight.” Then Ananias answered, “Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem. And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name.” But the Lord said to him, “Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name’s sake.” And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” Immediately there fell from his eyes *something*

like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized. So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the disciples at Damascus.”

Responsive Confession:

Belgic Confession Article from 29

Elder: What are the marks by which the true Church is known?

Congregation: *The pure doctrine of the gospel is preached there and the pure administration of the sacraments, as instituted by Christ, is kept there.*

Elder: Church discipline is exercised there for the punishing of sin. There, all things are managed according to the pure Word of God, and all things contrary thereto are rejected.

Congregation: *In the true Church, Jesus Christ is acknowledged as the only Head. Those who are members of the Church may be known by the marks of Christians.*

Elder: They have true faith; and when they have received Jesus Christ the only Savior, they avoid sin.
