“Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have *the gift of* prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. And though I bestow all my goods to feed *the poor*, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing. Love suffers long *and* is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails. But whether *there are* prophecies, they will fail; whether *there are* tongues, they will cease; whether *there is* knowledge, it will vanish away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away. Responsive Confession:

WLC 136

Elder: What are the sins forbidden in the sixth commandment?

Congregation: *The sins forbidden in the sixth commandment are, all taking away the life of ourselves, or of others, except in case of public justice, lawful war, or necessary defense.*

Elder: Also the neglecting or withdrawing the lawful and necessary means of preservation of life.

Congregation: *Sinful anger, hatred, envy, desire of revenge; all excessive passions, and distracting cares are also forbidden.*

Elder: As are the immoderate use of meat, drink, labor, and recreations; along with provoking words, oppression, quarreling, striking, and wounding.
