### CONFESSING CHRIST

*Hebrews 10:1-10*

"For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. But in those *sacrifices there is* a reminder of sins every year. For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins. Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "*Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Then I said, "Behold, I have come — In the volume of the book it is written of Me — To do Your will, O God.*" Previously saying, "*Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them*" (which are offered according to the law), then He said, "*Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God.*" He takes away the first that He may establish the second. By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

## CONFESSION OF FAITH AND PRACTICE

(paraphrased responsive)

Responsive Confession:

WCF 16.1-3

**Elder:** Good works are only those works that God has commanded in His holy Word.

**Congregation:** *They are not works which, without the guidance of Scripture, are devised by men whether out of blind zeal, or upon any pretense of good intention.*

**Elder:** These good works, done in obedience to God’s commandments, are the fruits and evidences of a true and lively faith.

**Congregation:** *By these good works Christians manifest our thankfulness, strengthen our assurance, edify our brethren, adorn the profession of the Gospel, stop the mouths of adversaries, and glorify God, whose workmanship we are.*

**Elder:** Christians are created in Christ Jesus to do these good works, which are the fruit of holiness, and to enjoy God’s perfect plan for us, which is eternal life.

**Congregation:** *Our ability to do good works is not at all of ourselves, but wholly from the Spirit of Christ.*

**Elder:** Believers, to be capable of these good works need much help from God.

**Congregation:** *Beside the graces we have already received, there is required an actual influence of the same Holy Spirit, to work in us to will, and to do, of His good pleasure.*

**All: Yet are we not to become negligent, as if we were not bound to perform any duty unless upon a special motion of the Spirit; but we ought to be diligent in stirring up the grace of God that is in us.**

## SERMON NOTES

“True Christianity: Part II”

*Philippians 3:3-6*

**1** Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. For me to write the same things to you *is* not tedious, but for you *it is* safe. **2** Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the mutilation! **3** For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh, **4** though I also might have confidence in the flesh. If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the flesh, I more so: **5** circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, *of* the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of the Hebrews; concerning the law, a Pharisee; **6** concerning zeal, persecuting the church; concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless. **7** But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. **8** Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ **9** and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which *is* from the law, but that which *is* through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; **10** that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, **11** if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.
