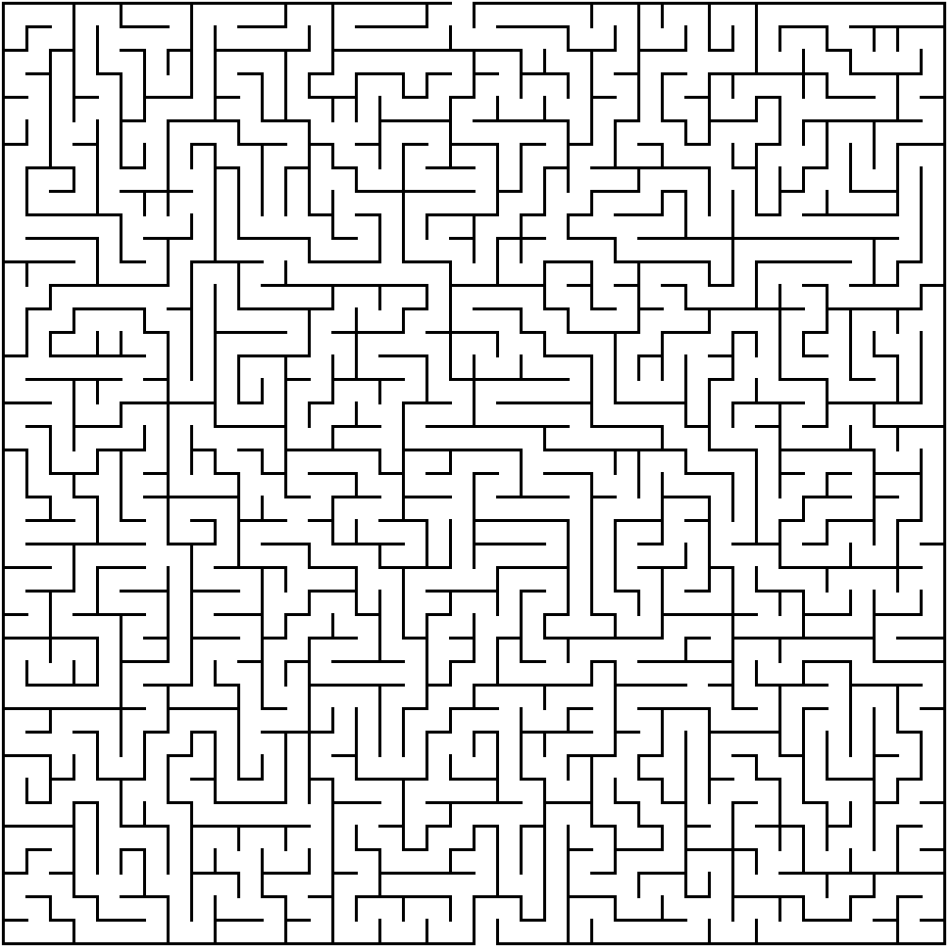
SERMON NOTES
