SERMON NOTES

“From Abyss to Awe”

Jonah 1:17-2:10

1:17 Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights. **2:1** Then Jonah prayed to the LORD his God from the fish’s belly. **2** And he said: “I cried out to the LORD because of my affliction, And He answered me.” Out of the belly of Sheol I cried, *And* You heard my voice. **3** For You cast me into the deep, Into the heart of the seas, And the floods surrounded me; All Your billows and Your waves passed over me. **4** Then I said, ‘I have been cast out of Your sight; Yet I will look again toward Your holy temple.’ **5** The waters surrounded me, *even* to my soul; The deep closed around me; Weeds were wrapped around my head. **6** I went down to the moorings of the mountains; The earth with its bars *closed* behind me forever; Yet You have brought up my life from the pit, O LORD, my God. **7** “When my soul fainted within me, I remembered the LORD; And my prayer went *up* to You, Into Your holy temple. **8** “Those who regard worthless idols Forsake their own Mercy. **9** But I will sacrifice to You With the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay what I have vowed. Salvation *is* of the LORD.” **10** So the LORD spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry *land*.
