"Gracious and Merciful"

Jonah 4:1-4

4:1 But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he became angry. **2** So he prayed to the LORD, and said, "Ah, LORD, was not this what I said when I was still in my country? Therefore I fled previously to Tarshish; for I know that You *are* a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm. **3** Therefore now, O LORD, please take my life from me, for *it is* better for me to die than to live! **4** Then the LORD said, "*Is it* right for you to be angry?"
