## SERMON NOTES

“The Hallmark of God's Children”

*1 John 3:11-18*

**11** For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, **12** not as Cain *who* was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous. **13** Do not marvel, my brethren, if the world hates you. **14** We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death. **15** Whoever hates *his* brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. **16** By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down *our* lives for the brethren. **17** But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him **18** My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.
