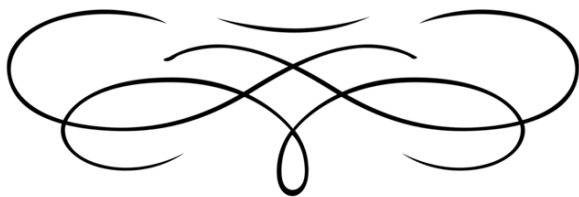

CONFESSING CHRIST

SERMON NOTES

“Glorifying God, Part 4”

John 20:11-18

11 But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down *and looked* into the tomb. **12** And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain. **13** Then they said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping?” She said to them, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.” **14** Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus. **15** Jesus said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?” She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, “Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away.” **16** Jesus said to her, “Mary!” She turned and said to Him, “Rabboni!” (which is to say, Teacher). **17** Jesus said to her, “Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, ‘I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and *to* My God and your God.’ ” **18** Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and *that* He had spoken these things to her.

- * Kathy is praying for better health & less pain.
- * Dorena is seeking a place to live.
- * LaVerne is requests prayers for a sick cousin.
- * Wayne is having problems with his legs.

Fun facts from this past Wednesday's pantry event:

- * We had 26 shoppers representing 75 people total.
- * There were 2 new shoppers.
- * Some of what we gave out:
 - 23 pounds of butter (\$2.12 each)
 - 22 dozen eggs (average: \$1.42/dozen)
 - 29 packages of cheese (average: \$1.40 each)
 - 41 bread items (burger buns & baguettes)
 - 95 packages of frozen meats, including:
 - 17 packages of bacon (\$1.19 each!)
 - 27 packages of beef & pork (average: \$3.38)
 - 15 packages of salmon (\$3.99 each)
 - 21 packages of frozen veggies (average: \$1.23)
- * It's pollen season, so we gave away boxes of tissues!
- * Ruth brought her guitar & we had Easter treats!

Want to shop for the pantry? We need stuff!

- * cans of vegetables, especially less-common kinds
- * cans of fruit (any kind), applesauce cups
- * cans of tuna, sardines, or oysters
- * cans of ravioli, beef stew, chili, or meaty soups
- * bags of rice (1-lb size, white or brown)
- * boxes of dry pasta (12 - 16 oz size, any shape)
- * jars of pasta sauce (23 - 24 oz size, any flavor)
- * taco or skillet-dinner meal kits
- * honey ("bear" bottle), jelly, or jam (any flavor)
- * jars of peanut butter (15-16 oz size)
- * boxes of crackers, especially saltines
- * hygiene items of any sort, especially feminine hygiene items (we can divide larger packages)
- * BIBLES! We need some Bibles! To be more specific, NKJV, NIV, or ESV Bibles! We like to give Bibles!
