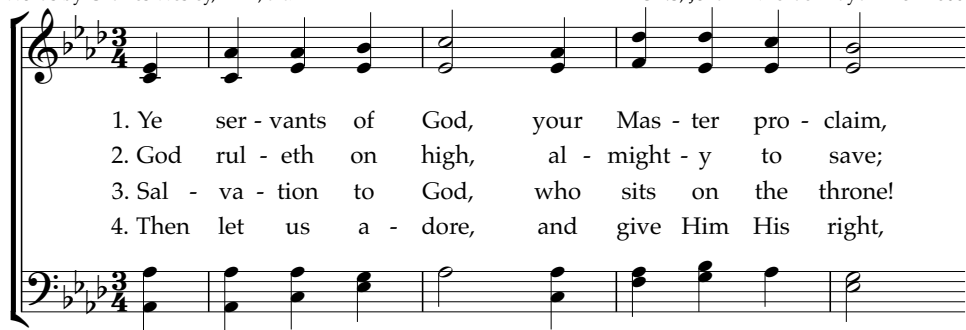
Colossians 3:18–4:1

18 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. **19** Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them. **20** Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord. **21** Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged. **22** Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God. **23** And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, **24** knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ. **25** But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality. **4:1** Masters, give your bondservants what is just and fair, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven.

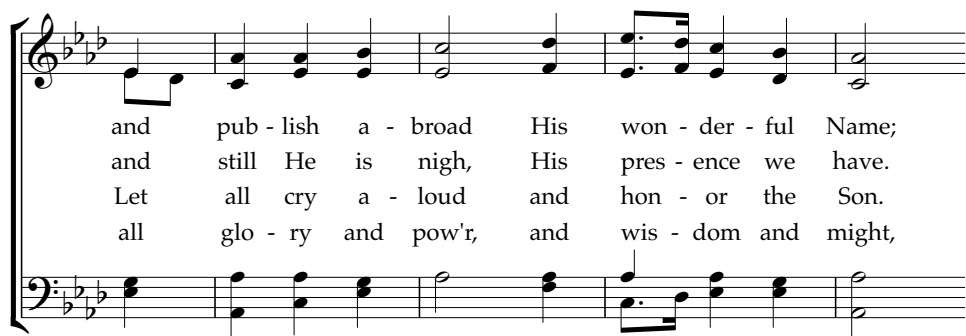
